

10 Ways to Implement the Mark Project

1. Use the bulletin announcements to promote Project Mark
2. Encourage individual reading and reflection
3. Encourage individual reading and journaling
4. Encourage individual reading and group reflection.
5. Sponsor a group to gather weekly to talk about what they've read
6. Sponsor a Bible Study using Little Rock resources
7. Sponsor a weekly Bible study using diocesan AV resources.
8. Offer people a print copy of the Gospel that people will read

 - In the bulletin
9. Start (and monitor) a blog for people to exchange ideas about their reading.
10. Read the weekly Marcan selections:
 - At the beginning of staff meetings
 - At the beginning of committee meetings
 - At youth gatherings
 - With catechists and other volunteers
