

# *Called to Holiness*

A day of reflection for professional ministers

## Questions and Answers

### **What is *Called to Holiness* and why has it been developed?**

*Called to Holiness* is a day of reflection designed to provide professional ministers with an opportunity to gather for prayer and reflection with other ministers. *Spirit Alive!* is both a call and an opportunity for those of us who serve as professional ministers in the Church to renew our own spirituality. This day of reflection will offer groups of professional ministers a time apart for reflection and personal growth in faith in the company of fellow ministers.

### **Who are the leaders for *Called to Holiness*?**

18 pastoral ministers have agreed to make themselves available to offer this day of reflection for professional ministers. They have all participated in a two day training experience led by Dr. Damian Zynda and they have all received both a model and materials for the day of reflection.

### **How will it be offered?**

Bishop Cark has invited all professional ministers to schedule a day of reflection as part of their commitment to *Spirit Alive!*

### **How can a group of professional ministers schedule this day of reflection?**

As a group, determine a time, date and location for your day together. Then contact one of the leaders and request that they facilitate *Called to Holiness* for you. You can negotiate date, time, place and stipend with the individual presenter. (Guideline for stipend is \$50 per hour). Please call as soon as possible to schedule your experience. If you hope to schedule during Advent or Lent, the earlier you can call the more likely that your request can be accommodated.

### **Who can participate?**

Parish staffs, regional gatherings of ministers, small groups of ministers who are interested can all take advantage of this opportunity. The optimum number for any gathering is 12-15 people.
